E-FELICITATION CEREMONY



The programme started in the evening hours displaying an amalgamation of entertaining events like music, drama, dance etc. The motivational messages by


teachers were highly inspiring for all the students. The audience of the evening the parents & the students forwarded their courtesy messages through the chatbox.
