These selected students will be awarded by the Minister of Education, Shri. Madan Dilawar ji. Congratulations!! Team SPSS

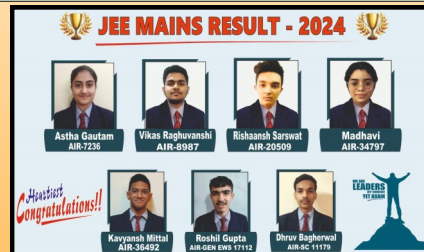
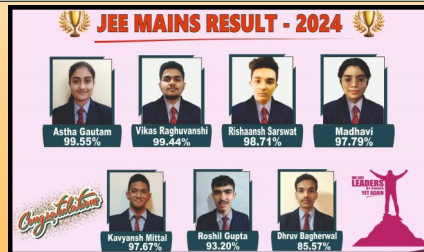
