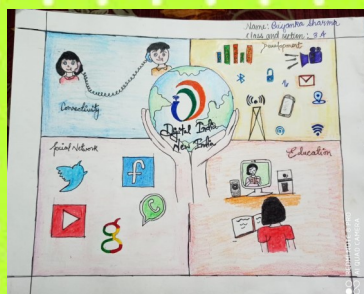

Dancing Droplets



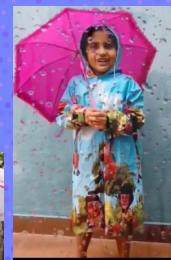
The month of July started with pitter-patter of raindrops. The beautiful breeze with the raindrops soaking the soil was the best thing for Mother Earth as well as for kids.

Beautiful poems were recited in the enchanting voice of the little ones compelled the rain drops to dance.



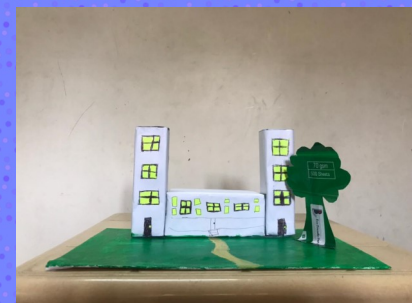
Young Architects

Contest for students of class III-VI, on 29th July'21, where both boys and girls made beautiful ornaments for themselves using the popcorn in all the creative ways they could.



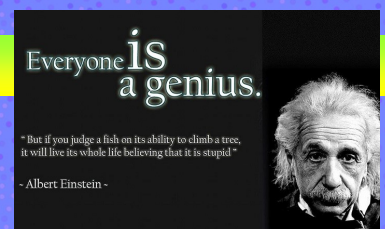
Model Making

Our motto ' Learning with Innovation ' is our guiding force and we remain committed to our endeavor.

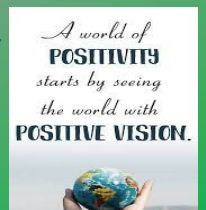
The holistic approach of the institute stimulates innovation among the students by inspiring fresh ideas with different perceptiveness, creative thinking and strong conviction.

I wish and pray that every child who passes through the portals of SPSS be a blessing to the society.

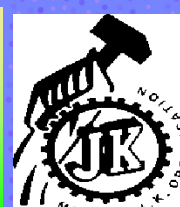
